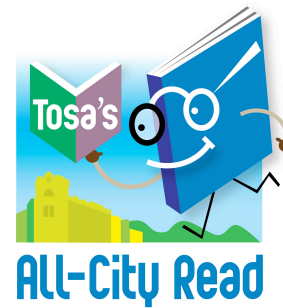


**Tosa's All-City Read
