2. First and second place cash prizes will be awarded by age level:  
Grades 3-5: \$30/\$20 Middle school: \$50/\$30 High school: \$75/\$40 Adult: \$100/\$60
3. Your response must be your own creation and not a retelling of the story.
4. You may use any medium including, but not limited to, paint, pen and ink, pencil, pastel, fiber, printmaking or digital media that can be printed out.
5. Winning pieces will be displayed at City Hall during February, so entries must be framed or matted. Digital art must be printed.
6. Finished pieces may be dropped off at the Reference Desk (upstairs) of the Wauwatosa Public Library, 7635 W. North Avenue, between January 18 and January 25, 2019.
7. Please make sure that your name is written clearly on the back of your piece.
